Oct 23, 2025 2 nd Pre-Election	9/21/25 - 10/18/25	<u>401</u>	• File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 4, 2025 election.
Feb 2, 2026** Semi-Annual	10/19/25 - 12/31/25	<u>401</u>	All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.

Additional Notes:

- * Period Covered: The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- ** Deadline Extensions: Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such a report must be filed within 24 hours, regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** Unless otherwise noted, all paper filings may be filed by mail. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing under a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party to list a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
- **Public Documents:** All statements are public documents.
