## FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WORKERS COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR VOLUNTEER EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission supports and is deeply appreciative of the efforts of volunteers who are performing services for the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission desires to provide workers' compensation coverage to volunteers who are performing services for the Commission; and

WHEREAS, California Labor Code Section 3363.5 allows a state agency to extend workers' compensation coverage to volunteers that perform services for the agency upon an affirmative resolution of the agency's governing board;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the members of the Fair Political Practices Commission hereby extend workers' compensation coverage pursuant to California Labor Code Section 3363.5 to a volunteer who performs services for the Commission insofar as the volunteer's offer of uncompensated services has been accepted as part of a volunteer program approved by the Commission's Executive Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission's Executive Director is hereby delegated the authority to promulgate a list of approved volunteer programs and to provide each existing and new volunteer with an acknowledgement of the volunteer's coverage under the Commission's workers' compensation plan.
