2 Adopt 2 Cal. Code Regs. Section 18313.6 to read:

3 **§ 18313.6. Online Posting: Redacting Personal Information.**

4 (a) An elected officer with a reasonable privacy concern related to the online posting  
5 under Regulation 18313.5(b) of an individual’s address, or a family member’s name or other  
6 personally identifiable information, may file, simultaneously with the filing of the original non-  
7 redacted statement, a copy of any required statement for online posting redacting the following:

8 (1) The address of the individual.

9 (2) The name of the family member.

10 (3) The address of an entity at which the family member is employed.

11 (4) The name of any entity if the name of the entity would reveal the name of the family  
12 member or the address at which the family member lives or is employed.

13 (b) Any official filing a redacted statement pursuant to subdivision (a) shall also file an  
14 original non-redacted statement containing all information required under the Act. The redacted  
15 statement shall be attached to the original non-redacted statement, and the official must include a  
16 written notification clearly identifying for the Commission what information has been redacted,  
17 and explaining the basis for the redaction under (a)(1)-(4), above.

18 (c) Names or addresses redacted as specified in subdivision (a) shall be clearly designated  
19 as redacted on the schedule on which the name or address would otherwise appear.

20 (d) Any redacted statement filed for online posting under subdivision (a) shall be subject  
21 to the review of Commission staff, as delegated by the Commission’s Executive Director. If it is  
22 determined that the official has redacted information other than that permitted by this regulation,

1 the official shall be provided with no less than 30 days to amend his or her redacted statement  
2 prior to the online posting of the official's original non-redacted statement.

3 (e) For purposes of this regulation a family member includes an official's spouse or  
4 former spouse; child or step-child; parent; grandparent; grandchild; brother; sister; current or  
5 former parent-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law; nephew; niece; aunt; uncle; grand nephew;  
6 grand niece; grand aunt; grand uncle; first cousin; first cousin once removed; or spouse or former  
7 spouse of these persons other than a former in-law.
