

1 Amend 2 Cal. Code Regs., Section 18450.11 to read:

2 **§ 18450.11. Spokesperson Disclosure.**

3 (a) A report must be filed, pursuant to Section 84511, whenever a committee does either
4 of the following:

5 (1) Makes expenditures that total in the aggregate \$5000 or more to an individual for his
6 or her appearance in an advertisement.

7 (2) Makes expenditures of any amount to an individual for his or her appearance in an
8 advertisement that states or suggests that the individual is a member of an occupation that
9 requires licensure, certification, or other specialized, documented training as a prerequisite to
10 engage in that occupation.

11 (b) For purposes of the report filed pursuant to Section 84511 and this regulation,
12 “expenditure” has the meaning set forth in Section 82025.

13 (c) The report filed must contain the following information:

14 (1) The committee's name, street address and committee identification number;

15 (2) The name, ballot number or letter and jurisdiction of the measure;

16 (3) The date of the expenditure;

17 (4) The name and address of the individual who appears in the advertisement; and

18 (5) The occupation of the individual who appears in the advertisement when filing a
19 report pursuant to paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) of this regulation; and

20 (6) The total amount of the expenditure.

21 (d) Any committee subject to the electronic reporting requirements of subdivision (a) of
22 Section 84605 must file this report electronically.

1 (e) A committee that is required to maintain documentation evidencing appropriate
2 license, certification, or other training pursuant to subparagraph (d)(2)(B) of Section 84511 must
3 provide the documentation to the Commission within 24 hours of the Commission's request by
4 forwarding copies of the documentation to the Commission by electronic mail.

5 (f) For purposes of Section 84511, a committee makes an “expenditure” and must file the
6 report required under Section 84511 and include the paid spokesperson disclosure on an
7 advertisement when the committee coordinates the payment for the appearance of the individual
8 with a person who makes the payment, but that person does not qualify as a committee under
9 Section 82013.
