Hello,

I'm writing to express concern with the new rule that 87200 filers must file using the FPPC's e-filing system rather than the Netfile system, which was approved for use by the FPPC. Doing so will make it more difficult for filers as they typically have expanded statements for various other agencies and are able to complete those in one entry using Netfile, but won't be able to do so in the FPPC's system unless provisions will be made to accommodate it. Additionally, it will make it more difficult for clerks to track whether they've filed and for the public to view the statements, which are currently available on city websites.

I tried searching the FPPC Transparency Portal, but don't find it to be user friendly. When I searched for "all", it did return hits, but it didn't have any filed dates so I had to open each file to determine the date. It also didn't return hits for the City Manager, City Attorney, and Treasurer, who are also 87200 filers.

I'm asking that the FPPC consider making an exception for filing platforms that were previously approved and continue allowing our 87200 filers to use the current systems or make adjustments to the FPPC system that will make it more user friendly.

Lastly, will there be training sessions for the system for Councilmembers?
