Oct 27, 2022 2 <sup>nd</sup> Pre-Election	9/25/22 – 10/22/22	<u>401</u>	<ul> <li>File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 8 election.</li> </ul>
Jan 31, 2023 Semi-Annual	* - 12/31/22	<u>401</u>	All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.

## **Additional Notes:**

- \*Period Covered: The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-Hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such report must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings may be filed by first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
- Public Documents: All statements and reports are public documents.
