Oct 22, 2026 2 <sup>nd</sup> Pre-Election	9/20/26 – 10/17/26	<u>401</u>	<ul> <li>File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 3, 2026, election.</li> </ul>	
Feb 1, 2027 Semi-Annual	* – 12/31/26	<u>401</u>	<ul> <li>All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.</li> <li>The January 31 deadline falls on a Sunday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.</li> </ul>	

## **Additional Notes:**

- \*Period Covered: The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours, regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings may be filed by first-class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- A slate mailer organization (SMO) receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or receiving payments from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should reference the <u>Slate Mailer Organization Manual</u> for information on reporting and disclosure requirements.
- Public Documents: All statements and reports are public documents.
