

2.09.060 - Campaign contribution limits.

- A. The provisions of this section are enacted pursuant to the provisions of Assembly Bill 571, and in particular, Government Code Section 85702.5, effective on January 1, 2020 and operative on January 1, 2021, allowing a county to establish campaign contribution limits for candidates for elective county office.
- B. There shall be no limit on the monetary contributions from an individual, entity, or committee to a candidate for elective county office in support of his or her candidacy.

Nothing herein shall affect the applicable reporting, disclosure, and recusal requirements related to any contributions as required by applicable provisions of law, including the Political Reform Act of 1974, as amended. (Government Code Section 81000, et seq., and applicable regulations promulgated thereunder.)
