STATEMENT OF RESPONDENT'S RIGHTS***

The Com plainant, the Enforcem ent Division of the Fair P olitical Practices Commission, and Respondent, both identified by nam e on the front of this docum ent, hereby agree that this Stipulation, Decision and Order will be subm itted for consideration by the Comm ission at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

The parties agree to enter into this Stipulation to resolve all factual and legal issues raised in this matter and to reach a final disposition without the necessity of holding an administrative hearing to determine the liability of Respondent.

Respondent understands and hereby knowingly and voluntarily waiv es any and all procedural rights under California Governm ent Code sections 83115.5, 11500, *et seq.*, and 2 California Code of Regulations sections 18361.4 thr ough 18361.11, including but not lim ited to the issuance and receipt of an accusatio n, and the right to appear personally and be represented by counsel at his or her own expense in any adm inistrative hearing held in this m atter, to confront and cross exam ine all witnesses testifying at the hearing, to subpoena witnesses to testify at the hearing, and to have an im partial adm inistrative law judge present at th e hearing to act as a hearing officer.

It is furth er stipu lated and agreed that Respon dent has violated the Po litical Re form Act as described herein.

Respondent agrees to the issuance of the Deci sion and Order and imposition by the Commission of a penalty in the am ount specified on the Stipulation, and a cashi er's check or m oney order in said am ount, payable to the "General Fund of th e State of California," has been subm itted by Respondent to be held by the State of Califor nia until the Comm ission issues its D ecision and Order.

The parties agree that in the event the Comm ission refuses to accept this Stipulation, it shall become null and void, and within fifteen (15) business days after the Comm ission meeting at which this Stipulation is rej ected, paym ents tendered shall be reimbursed to Respondent. Respondent further stipulates and agrees that in the event the Co mmission rejects the Stipulation and a full evidentiary h earing before the Com mission becomes necessary, neither a m ember of the Commission, nor the Executive Director, shall be di squalified because of prior consideration of this Stipulation.
